The town of Derry Parks & Recreation sponsors a Judo class held at Veterans Hall with instructor Roger Lenfest, a 3<sup>rd</sup> degree black belt and nationally certified coach. Mr. Lenfest is assisted by the founder of the Derry Judo Club, Chris Veziris, a 6<sup>th</sup> degree black belt and nationally certified coach, along with several other nationally ranked black belts. The Derry Judo Club teaches the art of Judo in a safe manner. Students who join are first taught conditioning exercises, then how to roll and fall. From there, in a structured and supervised setting, students learn throws and ground techniques, counters to throws and ground techniques, and depending on age and rank, students are also taught strangles and arm bars. The United States Judo Association (USJA) nationally sanctions all ranks given. All students who join the Derry Judo Club must also be a member of the USJA (see attached form). USJA membership forms can be obtained at the Derry Parks & Recreation office. All new participants must also fill out a Judo Photo Waiver, which can be obtained at the Derry Parks & Recreation Office.
